The Amity Teachers Association is offering grants to high school seniors at Amity High School who are planning to attend an institution of higher education. ATA officers in conjunction will determine the amount of each grant with members of a scholarship committee. It will also be contingent upon the availability of funds within the ATA treasury.

Students at Amity High will be made aware of such grants by high school administrative staff. Each student who is interested in a grant will fill out the application that is available in the ASPIRE room or from any ATA officer. A team made up of ATA officers, high school principal and high school counselor; along with scholarship committee members will make the final selection of the successful applicant.

Grant awards are solely for the purpose of books and academic supplies for the fall term of the student's freshman year. The student will submit receipts for reimbursements to ATA treasurer during his/her freshman year in college. The applicant will sign an agreement indicating that he or she will abide by the terms of the above requirements.

Grant awards will be announced at Senior Awards Banquet by an officer of ATA.

Selection criteria will include but is not limited to financial need, academic achievement, potential for college success, field of study in higher education, completeness of application, awards, extracurricular activities, grades, community involvement, etc.
