BRETT ROHDE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Brett Rohde grew up on the family farm five miles south of Amity. He had a fondness for nature and enjoyed the things a farm life afforded. He attended Amity schools all 12 years and always loved sports: loved to watch sports, loved to talk sports, and loved to participate in sports. He always tried to do his best, from T-ball to high school athletics; from academics to band; from 4-H to his church youth group. Brett was a quiet leader who felt teamwork was important. He worked well with others, helping them to do their best. Integrity, fairness and service were priorities to him.

Brett graduated from Amity High School in 2004 and from Linfield College in 2008. He worked in the Portland area as a CPA. He married in 2014, and he and his wife had a son in 2016. Brett was diagnosed with cancer in the fall of 2015 and passed away in March of 2017. He battled his cancer the same as he met any challenge, with dignity, a positive attitude, and he continued to care about others. He never once asked “why me” and looked on the positive side until the very end.

Brett loved life, God, and encouraging others. It would please him if this scholarship would encourage youth to pursue their education as well as the honorable traits that show true character.

GENERAL SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION

The Brett Rohde Scholarship is offered to encourage and assist an Amity High School senior who wishes to further their education at the college or vocational trade school level, with a preference given to a student attending a 4-year college. We will offer at least one scholarship up to \$1,000.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The scholarships will be granted on the basis of: quality of application, academic excellence, sports achievement, involvement in community and extracurricular activities, citizenship, and financial need. **Incomplete applications will not be considered.**

The student:

1. Is a senior enrolled at Amity High School.
2. Will complete the scholarship application and attach a current unofficial transcript. (request this in advance from the High School Head Secretary)
3. Will enroll in some form of post-secondary education the fall term following his/her graduation from high school.

PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

A letter outlining how to access funds will be provided when the scholarship is awarded. Funds will be made payable to both the student and the educational institution of their choice.
